Thursday, May 17th:

- Rowers will be excused from school at 12:00 pm. Buses will be loaded in the bus lanes outside the Commons. Buses will be departing at 12:30 pm.
- Please limit your luggage to a small bag and school backpack (and sleeping bag/pad if you are a rower that needs one). Your rower will be carrying their items on and off the buses,
- Parents DO NOT NEED TO DISMISS THEIR CHILD FROM SCHOOL. We have done this for the group.
- The bus will drive directly to Vancouver Lake.
- Arrive at Vancouver Lake at approximately 4:00 pm and immediately unload boats, rig and set up "camp." ALL ROWERS AND PARENTS are asked to help with this.
- Dinner will be served at the camp kitchen at Vancouver Lake for rowers and chaperones.
- Rowers will load onto buses with their gear and head to the hotel after dinner on Thursday.
- Mandatory lights out for all rowers at 10:00 PM.

- ***NO ROWER MAY LEAVE THEIR ROOM AFTER 10 PM FOR ANY REASON. IF YOU NEED SOMETHING, ASK YOUR CHAPERONE.
- Please keep your room/sleeping area tidy. We have multiple people per room and the housekeeping service WILL NOT clean up if they can't walk around easily.
- Get a good night's sleep for a busy and great weekend of racing.

Friday, May 18th & Saturday, May 19th:

The following is a rough example and at the whim of coaches/regatta coordinators:

- Departure schedules will be based on the coaches meeting the night prior to the start of the next day.
- We have rented a school bus that will make 2 morning drop offs and 1- evening pick up from the Lake to the Hotel.
- Departure times will be confirmed each evening by the coaches. All chaperones must be present at the end of the day for the meeting with coaches.
- Coaches/ Coxswains meeting Friday Morning at 6:30 AM at the race venue.
- Hot breakfast, lunch and dinner will be served from the camp kitchen each day
- Mandatory lights out at 10:00 PM for all rowers.
- ***NO ROWER MAY LEAVE THEIR ROOM AFTER 10 PM FOR ANY REASON. IF YOU NEED SOMETHING, ASK YOUR CHAPERONE.

Sunday, May 20th

- Rowers will depart the hotel in the morning (at your designated time) WITH ALL OF YOUR BELONGINGS. We will not be returning to the hotel again.
- Chaperones, please do a quick pass of the room to check for any/all left items before departing for the venue on Sunday morning. NO ITEMS LEFT IN THE HOTEL WILL BE RETURNED after we've checked out.
- There is no need to check out with the front desk.
- Races will conclude around 12 Noon.
- During the morning, ALL PARENTS and Rowers are asked to help in packing up the camp kitchen as much possible.
- All rowers are expected to stay at Regionals until the final race.
- Once the camp is packed up, boats are de-rigged and loaded and we've had a brief **ALL TEAM meeting**, we will depart--approximately 1:00 PM.

PARENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR GETTING THEIR ROWERS HOME ON SUNDAY. WE WILL NOT HAVE A CARPOOL!

Suggested Packing List:

- The weather forecast is varied- Please pack layers (we'll likely have temps from 50-85 degrees.) Bring extra socks, shoes, etc.
- Don't forget a rain coat, hat, sunglasses and sunblock.
- Don't forget your uniform (including your tech shirt.)
- Camp Chair & blanket for hanging out at the venue.
- Bring reading materials and homework. You will have ample down time to work on school work, etc.
- PLEASE HAVE YOUR NAME IN YOUR UNIFORM AND OTHER GARMENTS. It is the rowers responsibility (not the chaperones!) to keep track of his/her clothing/possessions.

Misc. Housekeeping:

- Please leave the hotel quietly each morning. Please be respectful of the other hotel
- The hotel phones may not be used for long distance calls. All phone call should be handled on personal cell phones.
- Your rower may want some additional spending money as there are numerous food and other vendors at the venue. Chaperones WILL NOT have extra money for rowers.
- We expect all rowers and parents to behave with good sportsmanship and respect for coaches and fellow rowers.
